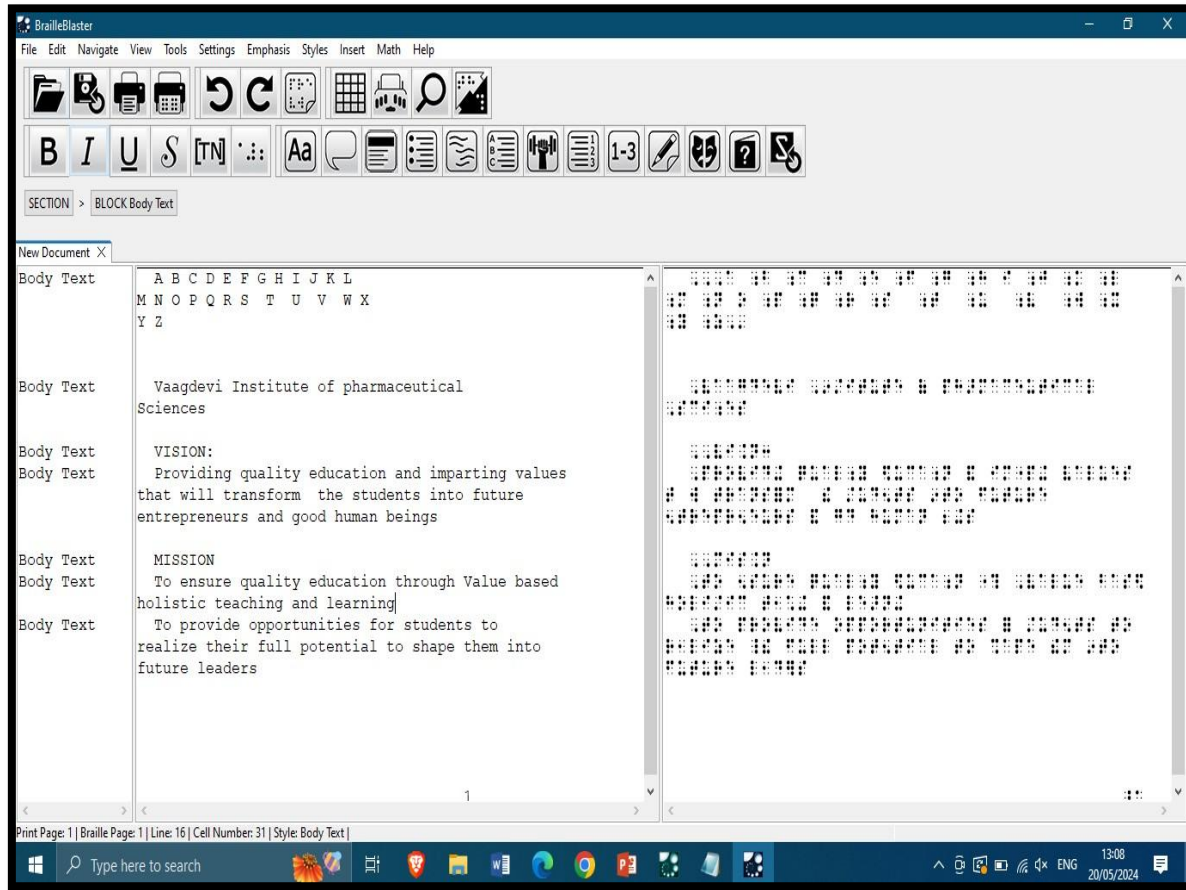

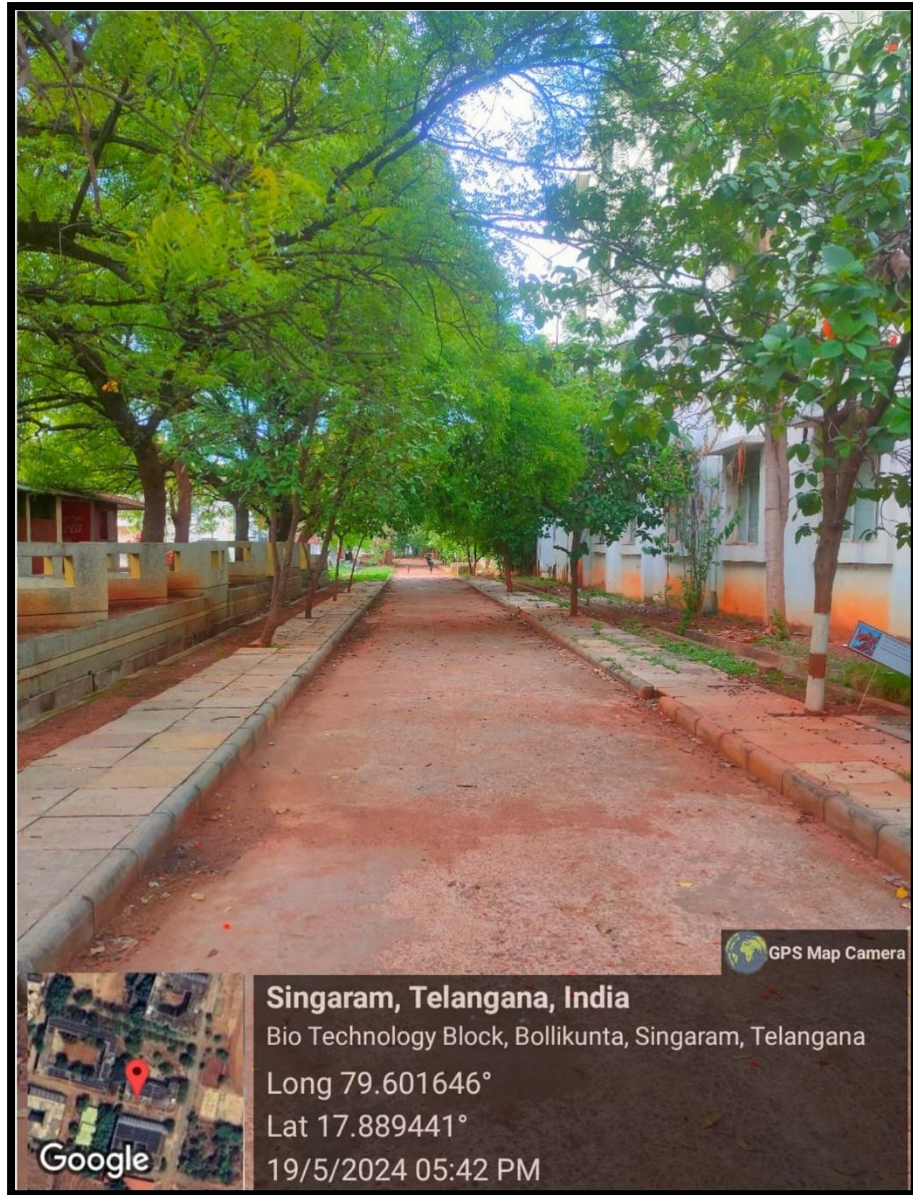

The Vice-Chancellor, in pursuance of the decision taken by the Executive Council at its 132nd meeting held on 01.06.2020, has accorded approval for the adoption of G.O. Ms. No. 10, Department of Women, Children, Disabled and Senior Citizens (Estt), dated 30.08.2018 of Government of Telangana (copy enclosed), providing reservation for differently abled persons in all Government establishments under the Rights of Persons with Disabilities Act 2016 (Central Act No. 49 of 2016).

ORDERS

Sub:- Kakatiya University - Disabled Welfare Extension of Concessions to Physically Challenged Students with Minimum percentage of disability shall be 40% of any kind of disability - Orders - Issued.

1. At present the following Concessions/exemptions are being given to the Deaf & Dumb, Physically Challenged and Blind students at to the Blind Students (professional & Non-Professional) admitted in the University Campus, Constituent Colleges and SDLCE:

DEAF AND DUMB:

- 1) Exemption from writing the General English papers under Part-I
- 2) Reduction of pass marks from 35% to 25%
- 3) Exemption from payment of examination fee
- 4) 30 minutes extra time in University examinations
- 5) Relaxation of jumbling system in University examinations

BLIND

- 1) Exemption from payment of examination fee
- 2) 30 minutes extra time in University examinations
- 3) Providing scribe (the Chief Superintendent should satisfy himself of total blindness of the candidate) Scribe should be of Degree Standard in subject other than the papers for which the candidate is appearing.
- 4) Reduction of Pass Marks from 35% to 25 for all subjects.

PHYSICALLY CHALLENGED:

- 1) Exemption from payment of Examination fee
- 2) 30 minutes extra time
- 3) Providing scribe to those who are in capable of using hands due to accident/illness.
- 4) Reduction of Pass Marks from 35% to 25 for all subjects

2. The Government of Andhra Pradesh through G.O.Ms. No. 27, dated 09/08/2000 prescribed the minimum percentage of disability as 40% of any kind of disability as certified by the medical authority to apply for facilities/concessions and benefits admissible under the schemes of the Government or Non-Governmental Organizations which is already adopted by the Osmania University.

3. The Director, University Hostels, Kakatiya University vide his letter No.35/Host/KU/2009 dated 8th September, 2009 has forwarded the applications of the Physically Challenged Students for free Boarding & Lodging facilities wherein stated to extend the following concessions in addition to the above as are implemented at Osmania University from 2008-2009.


- 1) Free Boarding & Lodging in the University Hostels.
- 2) Free ship to be given by the concerned Principals outside the regular quota.

4. The matter was placed before the Standing Committee of the Academic Senate at its 3rd meeting (2009-2010) for consideration. The Standing Committee of the Academic Senate while adopting the G.O. desired to refer the matter of extension of free boarding & lodging etc., to the Finance Committee for consideration.

5. The Finance Committee at its 76th meeting and the Executive Council at its 86th meeting held on 23.03.2010 has accorded approval for the implementation of the following benefits/concessions in addition to the above to the Physically Challenged Students with a minimum of 40% of any kind of disability as certified by the Medical Authority with effect from the financial year 2010-11:

- 1) Free Boarding & Lodging in the University Hostels.
- 2) Free ship to be given by the concerned Principals outside the regular quota.

6. Further, the Executive Council has accorded approval to provide a "SPECIAL PROVISION" under the Head(s) "Student Services/Welfare & Recreational Activities" in the Part-I: Non-Plan (Revenue) Budget Estimates to meet the financial commitment on this score for the ensuing financial year 2010-2011.
